## Code of Behaviour

The Club's Code of Behaviour for parents and spectators includes:

- Encourage children always to play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake. Positive comments are motivational.
- Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skilful plays by all participants.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Show respect for your teams opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.

These behaviours foster a positive environment where all players, coaches, umpires and parents can reach their potential.
